Meeting called to order by Commissioner Glenn Wilson at 7:00 PM. Robert Horn was also present. The purpose of this meeting was to meet with FST engineering firm about what should be done to correct the problem with bacteria in our water system. At 7:05 Donald Bunker and Kevin Gagne from FST engineering joined our meeting. The commissioners answered questions regarding our system. Mr. Bunker took notes and will be getting back to us with a proposal in the near future. Mr. Gagne came along as this engineering company is the same one the town is using in their side walk replacement project. The commissioners did ask Mr. Gagne if there were any provisions in the contract that would be going out to bidders of the project for broken or hit curb stops. He checked and found none. The commissioners are requesting that this be added to the contract for bidders. Commissioner Horn stated that he would draw up a clause and have it ready for our next regular meeting in February. The plan would include provisions for approx 30 curbs. After the commissioners approve the clause it would be submitted to Fay, Spofford, and Thorndike for including in the specs for the side walk project. At this time Kevin left the meeting and Commissioner Wilson and Horn along with Donald Bunker left the town hall to take a brief tour of our pumping station on Bible Hill Road. Mr. Bunker toured the building and we all return to the town hall parking where we all parked. Commissioner Wilson adjourned the meeting at 9:05PM, which was seconded by Robert Horn.
