Meeting called to order by Chairman Glenn Wilson at 1:00PM. Commissioner Landi was also present along with invited guest Donald Bunker from FST and town administrator Denise French. At 1:10PM, Selectmen Joseph Cuddemi, and road agent Gary Russell joined our meeting the purpose of this special meeting was to review the report from FST regarding the recommendations that this department are going to do to satisfy the NHDES. Don Bunker gave a detailed presentation on what the water department should do to satisfy NHDES. The commissioners agreed with all the recommendations, and agreed to proceed with the recommendations as soon as possible. Total estimated cost at this time, which includes all the recommendations, along with the engineering study are at approx 41,000. The recommendations also recommend that we hire a company to do leak detection every three years. Wilson stated in the past that Granite State Rural association was used to find minor leaks, but he was unsure at this time if they could handle the whole system. He will check with Operator Jim Cruthers. Also at that time when he talks with Cruthers, he will find out how much Cruthers is willing to handle, and if at that time he states he is not interested, the commissioners will make sure that a private contractor is contacted to make sure that this program is completed as recommended. There were a few minor mistakes on the draft copy, and Don has made the corrections, and will submit a new final copy the first of next week (March 30). At that time Commissioner Wilson will forward that information in the report to NHDES. With nothing else to discuss, the commissioners thanked Donald Bunker from FST for being able to attend. Glenn made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Sal Landi. The meeting was adjourned at 2:25PM
