Meeting called to order by Commissioner Glenn Wilson. Commissioner Sal Landi was also present. The commissioners signed the warrant for the second quarter, and are awaiting the signature from Rob Horn on the first quarter. The full time chlorination was discussed with the selectmen prior to this meeting. Commissioner Wilson has been in contact with operator Jim Cruthers, who states that the completion should be done by the end of this month. The flushing of hydrants was also discussed and dates of May 16 & 17 were established. Also rain dates of May 23 & 24 were also figured in. The water department reported that they have received authorization to use the Fire house software which the fire department has access to record hydrant maintenance and flow recording. Rob Horn in a conversation on May 12 with Commissioner Wilson stated that he has a change in his decision to him the third commissioner. The commissioners will be putting a request in the town newsletter, which is scheduled to go out with the tax bills at the end of the month. If no replies are received, then we will advertise in the local paper. The commissioners also discussed with the selectmen the need to have the fences at the pump house and the Starrett Road sewer pump house repaired. The selectmen agreed to have both fences fixed. The one on Starrett Road will be repaired after the brush is cut. The commissioners voted to hire Monadnock Fence do the work, with Commissioner Wilson scheduling the time with them. A review of the Charles Zabriskie Jr. account showed that there was a billing error. The commissioners signed abatement for the total of the second quarter billing, and will contact him to advise of same. With nothing else to discuss, the meeting was called to adjourn by Commissioner Wilson, seconded by Commissioner Landi.
